Thank you for booking into WATPA's club day 14th March weekend.

Facilities available: - We have plenty of parking room, there is a shower and toilet block next to the arena. In the large green shed there is another toilet, and we have full kitchen facilities with a fridge, microwave, kettle, plates, cutlery, mugs, tea, coffee, milk, and cool drinks available as well as water. We have a good number of plastic chairs but pack yours if you have one just in case.

For your horse you need yards, electric taped yards are fine and feed. Please do not hard tie anywhere on the property except to your float if you want. Please keep your dog at your camp or on a lead, please ensure your children are safe and supervised.

There are wash down bays for hosing your horses down, and we ask that you pick up any manure and leave the area tidy after use.

Catering: - We will be providing lunch on the day, please let us know if you have any dietary requirements.

The Program: - We have no expectations from you other than you enjoy your day and go away with some new information and a newfound love of Ranch Sorting (we hope). Please talk to us if there is something you want to work on, and we will do our best to accommodate. We are all volunteers doing our best and if there are ways, we can improve we would love your feedback.

Spectators/Fence Sitters: - Please invite your family and friends to come along, all are welcome, and it is free to fence sit, but everyone will be asked to sign in using the covid safe app. All spectators are to be within the designated area which is outside of the arena. No spectators are to be in the arena.

Insurance requirements: - As this is a training day you must wear an approved riding helmet, and a long sleeved shirt with a colour.

Dress code: - Human: Long or short sleeved western shirt, jeans, or jodhpurs, riding boots, helmet.

Horse: - Any gear as long as it is safe, no head checks or tie downs as these are unsafe around cattle, no whips while working cattle, bitless is accepted but no halters.

Waiver: - All riders must ensure they have signed a waiver before riding. Cathy Neale our President will be your first aider on the day.

Warm Up: - Riders can use the arena for warm up, and may use the dressage arena, which is separate to the Ranch Sorting yards and just past the green shed where the kitchen facilities are located. please do not warm up outside of the arenas. Entry to the arena from the parking area is at the top of the paddock accessed from the float parking area.

We may ask for extra helpers to make the day easier, please ensure you keep the area clean of any rubbish, with bins available in several areas around the venue.
